

Summary of research titled

The role of youth welfare agencies in the university in investing students' leisure time

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The problem of the study and its importance:

The sense of time varies from person to person, because of the difference in the degree of education, intelligence, social, cultural and civilization level.

There are those who consider leisure time a big problem that must be solved, and another believes that he does not have leisure time, and there are those who are considered all the time outside the official work is a time spent sitting at the cafe or spend in sleep or reading or exercise Favorites.

That is, everyone has his style and his way of spending leisure time, but where are the purpose, meaning, value and investment of this time in human life.

In this sense, our present study has focused on the role that the youth welfare agencies can play in the university in investing students' leisure time.

Study Questions:

- (4) What are the obstacles that limit the effectiveness of the role of the youth welfare agencies in the university in investing students' leisure time?
- (5) What are the proposed methods to activate the role of the youth welfare agencies in the university in investing students' leisure time?

Methodological procedures for the study:

- This study belongs to the pattern of descriptive studies, which is based on the social survey methodology in the sample for students of the third year at the Faculty of Social Work- Fayoum University -And the number of (200) sample.

- The study also applied to the employees of the youth welfare agencies at the university in a comprehensive survey method and they numbered (80) sample.

Study Tools:

- (1) A questionnaire for students to learn about the role of youth care agencies in the university in investing leisure time for students.
- (2) Investigating a questionnaire for the employees of the university youth welfare agencies at Fayoum University.

Fields of study:

1- The spatial field

The study was applied in the Faculty of Social Work, Fayoum University.

2- Human field:

- The study was applied to the students of the third year of the Faculty of Social Work Fayoum University, especially the participants in the activities of the Youth Welfare Authority in the faculty , and they numbered (200) sample.
- The study also applied to all employees of the youth welfare agencies at the university and they numbered (80) sample.

3-The Time field

Data collected during the period from 15/11/2007 to 20/3/2008

The results of the study:

The study concluded with a set of results:

- (1) There are risks of not investing in student leisure time.
- (2) The results of the study on the actual role played by the youth welfare agencies in investing students' leisure time proved that there are pros and cons related to this role.
- (3) The results of the study showed that there are difficulties that prevent the care of young people in turn to invest in students' leisure time.
