First: study objectives:

- ١- To Know the relationship between woman's work and satisfying social and psychological needs of her children from comparing between worker mothers' children and workless mothers' children.
- ٢- To know the most satisfying needs for children from mothers and female teachers' point of view.
- ٣- Attempt to reach to create a suggested imagination for the role of social work in satisfying kindergarten children's social and psychological needs.
