

## Abstract

### **Professional requirements to practice "Clinical Social Work" to work with the university youth groups to face " Student Violence"**

**A study that is applied on "Social Workers" at "Youth Care Offices" at Fayoum University**

**First: Study Problem & its importance:** It's recently noticed that "student violence behaviors" among university youth increased. Clinical social work is considered one of the professional practice roles through which social workers seek to help those individuals whose behaviors put them into challenging situations. It also, seeks to help individuals to modify their attitudes & emotions to overcome the behaviors that hinder their performance. Therefore this study seeks to search for the requirements of profession, knowledge, values and skills that are necessary to practice clinical social work during working with groups, especially, "University Youth Groups" so as to face "Student Violence" especially in our Egyptian community. The matter that makes it necessary to have new attitudes in the profession such as "Clinical Social Work" due to the existence of several varied problems that impose concentration on working with groups.

**Accordingly the study problem is identified in that question:**

**What are the professional requirements needed for social workers to practice "Clinical Social Work" during working with "university youth groups" so as to face "Student Violence"?**

**Second: Study Concepts:** professional requirements – clinical social work – university youth – student violence – the social worker at university youth care offices.

**Third: Study Objectives:**

- ١- To identify the professional knowledge requirements needed for social workers who work at "Youth Care Offices" to practice "Clinical Social Work" related to both during working with university youth groups to face "Student Violence".
- ٢- To identify the professional values requirements needed for social workers who work at "Youth Care Offices" to practice "Clinical Social Work" during working with "University Youth Groups" to face "Student Violence".
- ٣- To identify the professional skills requirements needed for social workers who work at "Youth Care Offices" to practice "Clinical Social Work" with "University Youth Groups" to face "Student Violence".
- ٤- To determine the most important advantages provided by the Social group Work method to practice "Clinical Social Work" during working with "University Youth Groups" to face "Student Violence".
- ٥- To identify the suggestions of the social workers who work at "Youth Care Offices" to activate the practice of "Clinical Social Work" during working with "University Youth Groups" to face "Student Violence".

- ٦- To reach a future view so as to activate the practice of "Clinical Social Work" during working with "University Youth Groups" to face "Student Violence".

- ٢- What are the professional values requirements needed for social workers who work at "Youth Care Offices" to practice "Clinical Social Work" during working with "University Youth Groups" to face "Student Violence"? requirements are at the level of( a) a university student as a member of the group –b) small student groups – c)the society of students, faculty, working Group and university foundation )
- ٣- What are the professional skills requirements needed for social workers who work at "Youth Care Offices" to practice "Clinical Social Work" with "University Youth Groups" to face "Student Violence"?
- ٤- What are the most important advantages given by the Social group Work method to practice "Clinical Social Work" during working with "University Youth Groups" to face "Student Violence
- ٥- What are the suggestions of the social workers who work at "Youth Care Offices" to activate the practice of "Clinical Social Work" during working with "University Youth Groups" to face "Student Violence"?

**Fifth: Study methodological procedures:**

- ١- **Study type:** This study belongs to the type of " Descriptive Analytical Studies".
- ٢- **Used method:** According to the type and nature of this study, the used method is the "**Comprehensive Social Survey**".
- ٣- **Study tools:** A special questionnaire for all social workers who work at "Social Care Offices".
- ٤- **Study Domains:**
  - a) **Spatial Domain:** This study is performed at all the faculties of "Fayoum University" (their number is ١٦ faculties).
  - b) **Human Domain:** Comprehensive social survey for all social workers who work at social care offices in the faculties of "Fayoum University" (their number is ٦٤ social worker).
  - c) **Time Domain:** It's usually determined by the duration of data collection represented in the period from ٢٧/١/٢٠١٦ to ٢٨/٢/٢٠١٦ .

**Sixth: Field Study Findings:**

The field study determined the most important requirements of profession, knowledge, values and skills that are necessary to practice clinical social work during working with

"University Youth Groups" so as to face "Student Violence". We reached the most important advantages given by the method of Social Group Work for "Clinical Social Work" to face student violence among university youth groups. Examples for these advantages: the collective experience that contribute to develop the desired social attitudes to treat behavioral disorders to face violence and to invest the existing skills, abilities and gifts among the members. It also provides opportunity for self free expression & exchanging ideas and eliminating intellectual suppression to lessen student violence. the method of Social Group Work is rich in sociometric & scientific scales beside the scientific models & remedial approaches that enriches the practice of "Clinical Social Work". Added to this its concentration on understanding the dynamics of a group and collective relations. We also reached a future view in order to activate the practice of "Clinical Social Work" during working with "University Youth Groups" to face "Student Violence".
