1- The CPU is the heart of the computer, a microprocessor chip

which processes data.

2- The main memory holds the instructions and data which are

being processed by the CPU.

3- Peripherals are the typical units attached to the computer. They include devices, which let us enter data and commands, and output devices which let us extract the results. At the back of a computer there are ports into which we can plug external devices (e.g. a scanner, a modem, etc.). They allow communication between the computer and the devices.
