#### **Abstract**

**Study problem**: The study problem poses the peculiarity of the correlative correlation between social and economic changes that occurred in the Egyptian society after the revolution of January 25, 2011 and the features of the Egyptian personality, because personality traits change with changing social and cultural structure, and that change is linked to social and economic factors.

**Systematic procedures for the study**: This study is an analytical descriptive study, in which the researcher used the social survey method, the content analysis, and the content analysis and questionnaire form, so a simple random sample of 500 individuals came from five governorates, namely Fayoum Governorate, Cairo, Aswan, South Sinai, Qena, and Aswan.

Results For the study: The results of the study concluded that there was a social, economic, and political change in the Egyptian society after the revolution of January 25, 2011, and this change affected the characteristics of the Egyptian character negatively, so a negative change occurred to it more than positive. Traitorous, impatient, and gloomy. The results of the study also found that the emerging traits on the Egyptian character are mostly negative traits represented in bullying and aggression, hatred, violence, lack of affiliation, condescension and showcasing on others, material in dealing, bribed, and opportunism, and the positive traits were that they became innovative and smart in some Sometimes, tolerant, religious, eager, friendly, loving to others, and bold, and that these features differ from one province to another due to geographical and climatic factors, commodity prices, and the neighbors that surround the person.
