"The Interrogative Expression 'Yā Hal Turā?!' in Communicative Context: A Grammatical-Semantic Study."

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Abstract:

The communicative question " Do you think?!" is one of the common idiomatic expressions in use since the ages of protest to the present day; with the aim of alerting the addressee and inviting him to think and reflect on the matter being inquired about without waiting for an answer from him. Hence, this research seeks to explore the characteristics of the syntactic structure of this expression, its patterns, and its effect in extending the time of the speech; because it is not based on the ignorance of the addressee, but rather motivating him to participate in producing the speech, which gives the speech movement and vitality, and success for its communicative dimension.
