

**The Reality of Electronic Bullying Phenomenon among the  
Secondary School Students in Fayoum Governorate and Ways to  
Confront It  
(A Field Study)**

**Abstract**

The current study aimed to define the nature of electronic bullying and its various forms, as well as the factors and theories explain it, to know the extent of the spread of this phenomenon among secondary school students in Fayoum, in order to reach proposals to reduce its spread. The researcher used the descriptive analytical approach, and used the questionnaire as a main tool for collecting information. The study sample was selected using random cluster method; it was applied to a sample of 132 male students and 127 female students of secondary school in – Fayoum Governorate. The study found that the prevalence rate of e bullying in secondary school students in Fayoum was average (2.08). Moreover, secondary school students in Fayoum practiced many forms bullying, as follows: ridiculing by ballot, defaming someone through –of e rumors, spreading false information or disturbing images, harassment, repeated insults in various forms, identity theft to embarrass or destroy and harassment, someone, disclosure of secrets, electronic prosecutions

Based on the results of the study, .finally defamation and impersonation the researcher put a set of proposals to reduce the spread of this phenomenon, taking into account the integration and synergy of all efforts among the institutions of social upbringing; the family, school and community institutions
