Abstract of the Seventh Research in English:

Study Problem: What is the role of environmental planning in promoting the circular economy as a strategic approach to confront environmental risks?

Study Objectives: - Main objective: Identify the role of environmental planning in promoting the circular economy as a strategic approach to confront environmental risks, and from this main objective the following sub-objectives branch out:

- 1- Identify the reality of environmental planning in Egypt.
- 2- Determine the requirements for applying the circular economy to confront environmental risks.
- 3- Monitor the necessary policies for applying the circular economy to confront environmental risks.
- 4- Detect the obstacles facing environmental planning in the transition to the circular economy to confront environmental risks.
- 5- Develop a proposed plan for the transition from the traditional economy to the circular economy to confront environmental risks.

Study Concepts: The concept of environmental planning - The concept of the circular economy.

Study Methodological: Type of study: This study belongs to descriptive analytical studies,

Study Method: The study relies on the quantitative and qualitative method based on the case study approach applied to local units and councils in Fayoum Governorate using the social survey method by sample for workers in local units and councils.

Study sample: The study was applied to a facilitated sample of workers in local units and councils in the centers and city of Fayoum Governorate (administrators - social workers) consisting of (210) individuals.

Study tools: The current study relied on a questionnaire form to collect data to determine the role of environmental planning in promoting the circular economy as a strategic approach to confronting environmental risks.

Study Findings: Among the most prominent results reached by the study are the lack of issuance of legislation supporting the application of the principles of the circular economy and the weakness of awareness campaigns to educate society about the importance of the circular economy and the weakness of cooperation between government and private agencies to support circular economy initiatives. There is also a lack of importance of the circular economy among workers in the environmental sector and the lack of clarity of legislative policies related to the circular economy in addition to the weakness of material incentives for institutions that adopt circular economy practices.
