Macedonian-Greek Colonialism in Egypt  During Ptolemaic dynasty (332-30 BC), the ancient Egyptian language was fast at adapting to the intercultural diffusion of the Greek religion into that of the Egyptian. This act almost certainly involved the apparition of some new words, and some other known words used to express other concepts, to match the Hellenization of some ancient Egyptian beliefs and practices. In this paper, the researcher is studying one case of the word grb. The aim of the present article is to build upon the analysis done in previous studies, to propose an accurate translation for the word grb and its meaning, and to demonstrate its political and socio-religious connotations, when the god Horus gives it to reigning Ptolemy. This analysis is performed on the basis of the inscriptions of Edfu temple, acting as representative of Ptolemaic and Roman temples.
