Governmental organizations (NGOs) Some Manual skills  
(A Training Program for Loom Knitting)**

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**Abstract:**

The subject of graduation project of the fourth division of the Faculty of Specific Education, Fayoum University, is considered as one of the subjects that the researcher believes can be used to qualify students for social integration and develop the concept of belonging to society and the country. The researcher considered the application of the orphans to the employees of a civil society in Fayoum governorate in the form of a training program so that the students of the society benefit from learning skillfully and materially in the use and sale of their products. A small source of income for them and a large profitable enterprise. The program was implemented by students of the fourth division of the Department of Home Economics, Faculty of Specific Education, Fayoum University under the supervision of the researcher on a sample of (20) students of the civil society, ages (11-16). After the program was implemented, a variety of different woolen products were produced by the trainees. It was accepted and appreciated by the civil society supervisors and the students themselves. The training program took two months, at a weekly session of three hours from 2 to 5 pm. The training program for each of the (specialists - trainers - trainees), and the coefficient of stability was 89%, a high stability coefficient. The products were judged by specialized and non-specialized arbitrators (consumers), giving a score of 1: 5, which is very good - good - to some extent - acceptable - does not exist. The arbitrators' form consisted of three main items with seven points. The arbitrators' agreement was 87%. This indicates that there is internal sincerity and consistency in the opinion of the arbitrators. Statistical analysis was done using the statistical package (spss16.0) to analyze the results.
