Yellowish discolouration of skin and sclera due to bilirubin more than 7 mg/dl

80% in preterm

60% in full term

Types: direct / indirect

Management of acute bronchiolitis

Mild rd: careful feeding/ close observation

Moderate to severe rd: should be hospitalized

Oxygen therapy

Proper hydration

Nebulized salbutamol

Steroids not indicated

Antibiotics not indicated

Mechanical ventilation may be needed
