* - research aims :

The research seeks to achieve a set of goals as follows:

First: Getting to know the masculine limit and the limit of the

womanhood at the grammarians. And their sections in terms of truth and metaphor.

Second: Explaining cases of remembrance of the act and its feminization with its perpetrator when obligatory and obligatory.
