

This research highlights on the theoretical and practical Military Ethics of Michael Walzer and other contemporary philosophers, and attempts to find moral answers worthy of discussing to the concept of Military Ethics and its roots, and the relationship between the concept of Military Ethics and the theory of fair war and the axes underlying them on which it is based and its conditions, discusses the quality of wars it accepts by Military Ethics. It also displays the quality of Ethical problems that prevent the application of such Military Ethics. as war crimes.

The basic ethical problem that arises in this research is that there is a gap between theory and practice, between the principles of ideal military ethics, before and after war and during the war, and the methodology followed and approach already adopted, the selfish utilitarian approach. there is difference between reality and intentions.

This Research confirms and emphasizes our need for a practical and global military ethics whose goal is to put an end to Horrific wars and establish lasting and just peace treaties, and to promote military virtues by military training for soldiers from military commanders on professional military ethics through career army life in the army.
