"Some Psychological Factors Associated with Domestic Crimes"

Abstract:

Family plays important roles to its members, especially its children, the more the society has strong relation among its members in general or between family members in particular, the more strong and progressive the society will be. It is of course true since the lack of closeness in such relation, will in contrast lead to the dissociation of this society, crimes in general and domestic crimes in particular have being increased. Domestic crimes reflects a lot of abnormality between family members so we are in need of this study in order to know personality traits of domestic criminals, to reduce the rote of domestic crimes.

The sample consists pf two groups, one of them was the experimental group, it consists of 30 criminals, they were a caused in domestic crimes and the mean age of them was 47, 9 year. The other group was the control group, it consists of 30 from normal, and the mean age of them was 49 year.

The following tools were administrated: clinical analyses scale, it is divided into two scales, they are diagnosing 28 of normal and abnormal personality traits, and a form of collecting main data about the sample was administrated. The results showed that, there were a relation between family member and domestic crimes, and there were a relation between lack of religion and domestic crimes. The clinical analysis of domestic criminals showed that there were a lot of abnormal traits in criminal's personality, they were: Dominance, Sensitivity, Suspiciousness, Insecurity, Radicalism, Tension, Hypochondriasis, Suicidal depression, agitation, anxious depression, low energy depression, boredom & withdrawal, paranoia, psychothenia and psychological inadequacy
