ABSTRACT

The Aims of the study: The current study aims at identifying the nature of the relationship between the value patterns and some psychosomatic disorders represented in (eating and sleep disorders) of the married leading woman and the belated married woman. It also aims at investigating the nature of the differences between the married leading woman and the belated married woman in both the value patterns and the eating and sleep disorders, The study Sample:The sample of the study consists of two groups. The first group is the pilot study. It consists of forty (40) woman divided into: twenty (20) married leading woman and twenty (20) belated married leading woman .The second group

represents the study sample. It consists of eighty nine (89)woman divided into : fifty two (52) married leading woman and thirty seven (37) belated woman. Their ages are between 35-48 years old. The study tools: The researcher used Demographic data form (designed by the researcher), value pattern measure (designed by the researcher), Sleep isorders measure (designed by Boshra Ismail Ahmed, 2013), Eating disorders measure (designed by Bothayna Mohammed Samer, 2010), The Study Results: There is a statistically significant difference between some value patterns represented in (theoretical, aesthetic and economical values) and some Psychosomatic disorders represented in eating and sleep disorders of the married leading woman and the belated married woman, There is no statistically significant difference between some other value patterns represented in (The political, Social and Religious values) and somepsychosomatic disorders represented in eating and sleep disorders of the married leading woman and the belated married woman. There are statistically significant difference between the married leading woman and the belated married woman in the anorexia nervosa disorder in favor of the belated married woman, There are no statistically significant differences in the bulimia nervosa disorder and chaotic eating, There are statistically significant difference between the married leading woman and the belated married woman in the sleep disorder, There are statistically significant difference between the married leading woman and the belated married woman in value patterns.
