## **ABSTRACT**

The current study aims to answer a fundamental research question: Is there a statistically significant relationship between Internet addiction and each of the quality of life and marital satisfaction in a sample of Married People? The study also aims to find out the differences between internet addicts and non-addicts of the internet in both quality of life and marital satisfaction. The study was conducted on a sample of  $(\vee \cdot)$  of Internet addicts and non-addicts of the internet, male and female couples and married in the age group (Yo-\(\xi\)o) years, provided that the length of marriage is two years, and providing education level is the average. The sample was divided into two groups: The first group, consisting of  $(7^{\circ})$  of the internet addicts, the second group, consisting of  $({}^{\circ})$  is non-addicted to the Internet. The sample were classified by their scores on a scale of internet addiction, and the number of hours they spend in front of the Internet.

## In order to verify the hypotheses of the study, the following tools were applied:

## The most important findings of the study were as follows:

- \text{\congruence}. There is a negative statistically significant relationship between scores internet addiction and each of the dimensions of quality of life (the greater use of the Internet, the less pleasant the quality of life).
- Y. There is a negative statistically significant relationship between scores internet addiction and and each of the dimensions of marital satisfaction.
- ". There are statistically significant differences between mean scores of internet addicts and non-addicts of the Internet on the quality of life scale for the benefit of non-addicts of the Internet.
- <sup>£</sup>. There are statistically significant differences between mean scores of internet addicts and non-addicts of the Internet on marital satisfaction scale for the benefit of non-addicts of the Internet.
