Abstract

Background: The analysis of strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats "SWOT," has long been used to evaluate the objective(s) of a specific pedagogical program. **Aim**: this study aimed to examine and compare the strengths and weaknesses, opportunities and threats related to maternity courses from the viewpoints of nursing students of (A) and (F) Faculties of Nursing who had just completed their respective maternity care courses at the time of the investigation.

Methods: A comparative analytic design involving third-year students was carried out in (A) and (F) Faculties of Nursing during the academic year 2015/2016. Results: The response rate of students was more than eighty percent from (F) Faculty of Nursing and greater than fifty percent of students from (A) Faculty of Nursing. A statistical significant difference found in course objectives; innovation methods of teaching; and the adequacy of the learning environment between participants. Conclusion: The study identified the gaps for achieving the objectives of maternity courses in both Faculties. Recommendations: Utilization of positive points garnered from the investigation and addressing negative findings in both courses.
