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The elements which affect the student participation in school activities with suggested imagination for the role of social work to face them.

A comparative study between the participant female students and that who don't participate.

(Within requirements of getting the master's degree in social study)

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Second : English Summary :

This study aims at :

- 1- Studying the factors that motivate to students to participate in school activities and defining the most motivating factors in this participation .
- 2- Studying the factors that lead to the non participation of girl students in the school activities and defining the most effective factors on this non – participation.
- 3- Comparing the responses of participant and non participant girl students in the school activities according to the measurements of the scale in order to define the factors that have an effect on participation.
- 4- Attempting to visualize a suggested role for social work versus the factors that lead to the non- participation of girl students in school activities

<u>Concepts of the study</u> :

The researcher has used the following three basic concepts in her study :

- 1- The concept of school activities .
- 2- The concept of Participation .
- 3- The concept of school social work .

Method of study :

1- Type of study : it is a descriptive , analytical comparative study.

2- **Type of curriculum** : The researcher has used the two types of social survey , namely comprehensive social survey and sample social survey . she has also used the comparative curriculum .

3- Fields of study

- A) Venue : A general secondary school and a commercial secondary school in the city of Fayoum .
- B) Subjects of study :
- 1- 140 participant girl in a general students in a general secondary school and a commercial secondary school.

- 2- 140 non participant girl in a general students in general secondary school and a commercial secondary school .
- 3-8 social workers.
- 4-18 school activities supervisors .
- 5-8 experts
- c) Duration of study :

Data has been collected during the period from 12-2-1992 to 16-4-1992.

4- Tools of study

- 1- A scale to study the effective factors on the participation of girl students in school activities .
- 2- interviews with female social workers, school activities supervisors and experts.
- 3- Statistical treatments such as k^2 test and "T" test using computers .

RESEARCH FINDINGS

- 1- Findings have pointed out that there are indicative differences between participant and non – participant girl students according to the measurements of the scale in each school where the research was carried out, with the exception of some factors related to school administration, as the scale proved to be non – indicative in the commercial school.
- 2- Some finding indicated that factors which have the most effect on participation and non participation (according to the order of the highest mean) are as follows :

First : Factors related to the character of the girl student :

- A) Factors that have greater effect on participation .
- 1- Participation in activities offers opportunities for social relations and new friendships .

- 2- participation in activities to acquire Knowledge and information in all spheres of life .
- B) Factors that have greater effect on nom participation .
- 1- The girl student's unawareness of the types of school activities .
- 2- The girl student's belief the school activities are a waste of time.

Second : Factors related to activities and supervisors :

- A) Factors that have greater effect on participation.
- 1- Good relations with activities supervisors increase participation in activities .
- 2- Supervisors' interest in activities and their encouragement to students to practice them .
- B) Factors that have greater effect on non participation in activities .
- 1- Insufficiency of hunnds allocated to school activities .
- 2- Inappropriateness of time assigned for practicing activities .

Third : factors related to school administration :

- A) Factors that have greater effect on participation .
- 1- Awarding prizes to students to encourage them to take part in activities.
- 2- The school administrators firm belief in the importance of practicing school activities .
- B) Factors that have greater effect on non participation .
- 1- Insufficiency of supervision and follow up of activities on the part of the school administration .
- 2- The school administration lack of encouragement to students to participate in activities .

Fourth : Factors related to family :

- A) Factors that have greater effect on participation .
- 1- Providing girl students with funds by the family motivates them to take part in activities .

- 2- The family's conviction of the importance of practicing of activities in addition to school subjects .
- B) Factors that have greater effect on non participation .
- 1- The family's misconception of activities do not allow sons and daughters to take part in school activities.
- 2- Families decline to allow their sons and daughters to practice activities at the end of the school day .
- (3) Findings have also indicated, through interviews with female social workers school activities supervisors and experts that the most effective factors on participation are :
- 1- Factors related to the character of the girl student.
- 2- Factors related to family.
