The role of civil society organizations in empowering Yemeni women

A study applied to workers in NGOs Hadramout governorate

Summary

The researchers tried, through the current study, to define the role of civil society organizations in empowering Yemeni women educationally, healthly, economically and in the field of combating violence against women in the city of Mukalla, and to identify the most important obstacles that limit the work of these organizations in the field of empowering Yemeni women. The study presented a set of proposals to activate the role of civil society organizations working in the field of empowering Yemeni women:

- 1- Activating cooperation between government institutions and civil society organizations that are concerned with women to reduce duplication of work and better investment of material and human resources available within the framework of the concept of partnership and networking in connection with the design and implementation of policies, programs and projects targeting women.
- 2- Expanding opportunities and options for women in the educational, economic, political and cultural fields and working to remove the obstacles that prevent women from accessing various resources.
- 3- To suggest methods and mechanisms that enable women to participate effectively in planning, implementation, evaluation and follow-up in an attempt to integrate women into development and in plans and programs aimed at achieving equitable development.
- 4- The necessity of renewing and expanding health services through the provision of infrastructure and primary health care and the provision of health personnel and qualified personnel to increase the level of health services provided to women.
- 5- The necessity of developing renewed and developed data and statistics that reflect the true participation of women and ensuring that gender is incorporated into Yemeni society development
