## NGO Board Members' views on the possibility of implementing the networking portal

A study applied to NGOs in Fayoum Governorate

## Summary:

The study aimed to describe and define the views of members of the boards of NGOs on the possibility of applying the entrance to networking in NGOs by defining their view on the concept of networking between NGOs, the goals and benefits that these organizations achieve, and their awareness of the requirements for success and effectiveness of networks between NGOs; the study was approved On the comprehensive social survey method in proportion to the type of descriptive study, based on the survey as a basic tool for collecting data from the study sample (members of the boards of directors of the selected NGOs in Fayoum Center) and they are (174) members represented by (32) NGOs. The study resulted in clarity of the concept and objectives of networking and its benefits for most members of the study sample, and that the factors of effectiveness and success of networks are mutual trust between members and cooperation and the ability to good planning and democratization of decision-making and the availability of funding and transparency, accountability and justice in the distribution of responsibilities and resolution of conflicts and the study recommended the importance of applying the networking entrance to achieve goals For the development of local communities
