## St Marc the Establisher of the Coptic Church

## **Research Summary**

The research aims to explain the importance of Saint Marc in several cultures as the western culture represented in the Catholic Religion, and the Egyptian culture in its both parts, the Islamic Culture and the Coptic Culture –the Orthodox Church – and to mention his history and his most important roles as establishing the Egyptian Church, the research aims as well to specify the actual place of his tomb, and to declare where is the different parts of his relic now, and his several shrine around the world, in the other hand to define if the different point of view for those several cultures had an influence on his icons and the way in which he is represented in the religious scenes in both the Catholic and the Coptic churches.
