Fayoum University is committed to establishing an academic environment that grants every student an equal access to education.

Here are various support programs and scholarships offered by Fayoum University to help low-income students access their higher education.

Tuition Fees Exemption:

The following students are fully exempted from tuition fees:

- a. Students with disabilities. Beneficiaries: 142
- b. Sons of martyrs and veterans. Beneficiaries: 11
- c. The first 500 outstanding students across Egypt. (for all students) Beneficiaries: 9

The fully students are partially exempted from tuition fees:

- a. Post-graduate students with disabilities (50% off). Beneficiaries: 88
- b. FU non-academic staff enrolled as a post-graduate student (25% off) Beneficiaries: 101

Scholarships

a. STEM students Scholarships. (for all students) Beneficiaries: 10
