الملخص باللغة الإنجليزية:

The artifacts that remain in the archaeological church of the Virgin Mary in the monastery of St. Abahor Al-Bahgory in the village of Sawada, east of EL-Minya.

The importance of the research lies in identifying the most important artifacts and manuscripts remaining in the monastery of St. Abahor El Bahgory, one of the monasteries located in the southeast of EL- Minya Governorate, which is not widely known despite its distinguished architectural design and contains a large group of artifacts and diverse manuscripts dating back to the eighteenth century, in addition to its proximity to the Church of the Virgin Mary in Jabal al-Tair, one of the most famous Christian religious shrines in Minya, in which the Holy Family resided on the way to their visit to Egypt. There are three churches in the monastery of St. Abahor El Bahgory, one of them is the archaeological church of the Virgin Mary, and the others are modern churches, one of them is named Saint Demiana and the other is Saint Mark's Church.

Despite the importance of this monastery and the importance of its archaeological church, it is not included in the internal or external tourist programs, so the topic of the research was of great importance in shedding light on one of the important Christian religious shrines with its antiques and manuscripts that are a witness to the most prominent features of Coptic art between the century seventeenth to twentieth century.
