الملخص باللغة الانجليزية:

This paper deals with the personal names associated with the *imA*—tree and its significance, since it was considered as one of the sacred trees. Its wood, fruits, and leaves were used in various purposes. Hence, this was perhaps the reason that it was included in various names and titles indicating this very fact. *ImA* had several variants in its pronunciation, like: *imA*, *iAm*, *im*, *imAt*, *imAyt imAw and imAwty*.

imA / imAw was used in 19 personal names from the Old Kingdom until the Greek-Roman period for both men and women. The study of this onomastic material allows a linguistic and anthropological reflection on the form and meaning of anthroponyms based on *imA*.

The study of these names aims to answer the question: Are there any particular links that has been united the ancient Egyptians to *ImA*? Moreover, the study of this onomastic material allows a linguistic and anthropological reflection on the form and the meaning of anthroponyms based on *ImA*. The names will be arranged according to the Egyptian alphabetical order.
