- Chapter Six: <u>Analytical Study of the Sanctuary Texts and Scenes</u>, analyzing the sanctuary's texts and scenes perception and context, while having the decorative program of the walls into concern.
- Chapter Seven: <u>Results and Conclusion</u>, briefing the whole study results in addition to, the thesis participation on the theoretical perspective, recommendations, opportunities for further research and final conclusion.
